#### Midnight Peony

Black tea leaves from Yunnan province. The rich, russet hue releases a floral aroma with notes of wine and molasses.

#### Jade Fortune

When steeped, Jade Fortune slowly unfolds with the grace of leaves dancing in the water. This premium tea, a golden brew, yields a pleasing nutty aroma.

#### Emerald Sun

This white chrysanthemum flower wrapped in green tea imparts a clear jade colour with hints of apricot and floral sweetness.

#### Dragon Lily

When steeped, sprinkles of osmanthus petals surface and an orange lily blossoms. Flavours of velvety sweet apricots.

### Green Sencha Tea

Plucked early in the spring, the tealeaves are steamed during the production process, capturing their youthful freshness. The tea has a light greenish-yellow colour, good body and delicious flavour of rice

### Afternoon Blend

Darjeeling teas are often referred to as the 'Champagne' of teas. Grown at altitudes up to 2,500 m above sea level, Darjeeling tea is light in colour with a delicate, muscatel flavour.
